

FLASF Video Entry Details

- 1) To enter, contestants are to submit an original video on the contest theme “**Science Can Fix That**” along with the entry and permission forms for each person on the team. You will also need to complete a release form for participants in the video itself (these forms are available on the FLASF website at: www.flasf.on.ca).
- 2) The final date for the submission of the video (uploaded to YouTube) and all forms, is **Friday, April 9, 2010.**
- 3) **Judging and Awards:** Entries will be judged on:
 - * Originality
 - * Creative imagination
 - * Scientific truths and relevance of ideas
 - * Ability to inspire
 - * Adherence to the contest rules

Prize: \$100, a Youth Science Ontario hoodie, and a trip to the Youth Science Ontario Showcase this spring for the screening of the award-winning videos. If 2 people create the video, each person will receive \$50 but both people will receive a hoodie and trip to Toronto for the screening.

These prizes must be accepted as awarded and have no cash value, nor are they transferable or refundable. There will be no substituted, except at the discretion of Youth Science Ontario. The odds of winning a prize are dependent on the total number of eligible entries received.

Contest Rules and Regulations

- 1) The video contest is open to Ontario residents only.
- 2) Contestants must be in grades 5 to 12 and enrolled full-time in an elementary or secondary school during the contest period.
- 3) The contest is limited to one entry per person. A video can be submitted by teams of up to 2 people.
- 4) Videos should be no longer than 3 minutes in length and must include in the title: “Science Can Fix That- 2010”
- 5) Video files must be in .avi, .mpeg, .mov, .wmv or .flv compressed video format at 640-480. Mobile phone videos can be uploaded at its original smaller dimensions.
- 6) The contest is void when prohibited by law.
- 7) Videos must be original work. Videos that have been previously accepted for another contest will not qualify for this contest.
- 8) Videos may NOT contain:
 - a) Any copyrighted or otherwise protected material for which you have not obtained permission to use, including but not limited to:
 - i. Music;
 - ii. Voice-over content;
 - iii. Images, photography, video, or art;
 - iv. Text; and
 - v. Trademarks.
 - b) Nudity, lewd, vulgar or offensive behaviour, language or gestures.
